Most of my time this summer has been spent meeting existing Liberal Party members and signing up new members. On August 14th, for example, I attended a small gathering at the home of Bill Cowie, president of the Ottawa Carleton Association for Persons with Developmental Disabilities (OCAPDD). Among other things, we discussed the Every Canadian Counts initiative and the merit of Canada following Australia's lead in implementing a National Disability Insurance Scheme. This is an area that has been of particular interest to me for many years, and is an important component of the broader discussion of how to ensure adequate income support and social services to prevent citizens from

On August 19th, I met organizers of a workshop for the Parents of Parkwood Hills Youth, and learned much more about the need for effective community activities focused on crime prevention and providing a healthy and secure future for our children.

On August 23rd, I had a very enjoyable meeting with community organizers and residents of Morrison Gardens, Penny Knox and Carissa Davis. We discussed the serious need for more and better social housing, and how to greatly expand meaningful job opportunities and bridging programs, especially for single mothers and youth. We also addressed the critical role that should be played by the federal government in ensuring all Canadians can lead dignified and productive lives, recognizing that the best social and economic policy is decent work for a living wage.



My ongoing door-to-door canvassing and other activities are taking me to all the interesting pockets and corners of this great riding, leading to innumerable enjoyable encounters with constituents. At the Muslim Summer Festival on August 2nd, for example, I had an invaluable opportunity to speak with many about a wide range of issues and concerns.



Like most Canadians, residents of Ottawa West-Nepean are thoroughly fed up with the diminished unambitious Canada of Mr. Harper. We are fed up with the manipulative Conservative playbook: pander to narrow constituencies, exploit regional differences, and bypass Parliament with the Prime Minister's Office.
